AptSoft Announces Integration of Its CEP Technology Platform with Oracle® Database 11g Rules Manager

AptSoft Director™ for CEP Release 5.0 to deliver a unified platform integrated with Oracle Database 11g Rules Manager for the development and execution of event-driven applications

BOSTON, MA – September 19, 2007 – AptSoft Corporation today announced it is accepting beta testing candidates for release 5.0 of its award-winning AptSoft Director™ for CEP, a technology platform for the development and execution of a new class of event-driven applications requiring Complex Event Processing (CEP). AptSoft Director for CEP Release 5.0 provides a unified development and execution environment with Oracle Database Rules Manager, the rich CEP feature of Oracle® Database. Aptsoft Director will support Oracle Database 11g and Oracle Database 10g Release 2. This virtually seamless interoperability will extend the use of CEP to a broader range of real-time, event-driven enterprise applications.

Complex event processing lets enterprises deploy applications capable of real-time detection, correlation and response orchestration based on information contained in events flowing through all layers of an IT infrastructure. This sense-and-respond model greatly improves the ability of an enterprise to identify and manage risk, exceptions and business opportunities.

“Many enterprises deploying applications such as EPC/RFID, fraud detection, risk analysis, compliance, CRM, and cross-selling require the real-time sense-and-respond capability provided by CEP,” said Steve Hagan, vice president of development, Oracle.. “By using AptSoft Director with Oracle Database Rules Manager, customers can benefit from the unique convergence, power and ease-of-use of these combined technologies.”

AptSoft Director for CEP includes a Design Center featuring a codeless user interface for defining all metadata objects as well as a high performance, low latency CEP Run-time Server for executing applications. Oracle Database Rules Manager automates an effective response to events of varying complexity that occur over a specified timeframe and application space with event-condition-action rules in the database. It can incrementally evaluate both structured and rich unstructured event data, including text, XML and spatial locations, with efficient access to multi-terabyte reference data sets. Aptsoft Director Release 5.0 extends the AptSoft Director Design

Center allowing the definition of both Director and Rules Manager metadata for events, rules, and actions. It automatically orchestrates the run-time execution of CEP rules as appropriate between AptSoft and Rules Manager.

Extending the AptSoft Director Design Center's graphical, point & click user interface dramatically improves the ease of defining and maintaining distributed CEP applications. Support for inter-operability between the AptSoft CEP Run-time Server and Oracle Database Rules Manager enables significant performance improvements to AptSoft applications when events originate within Oracle Database and when rule evaluation includes reference data stored in Oracle Database.

“Our experience implementing real-world CEP applications with our clients demonstrates the need to accommodate a wide spectrum of event sources and sinks (destinations),” stated Frank Chisholm, AptSoft CEO. “The integration of AptSoft Director release 5.0 and Oracle Database Rules Manager recognizes Oracle's vast installed base and the critical role of the DBMS in the practical deployment of CEP applications within the enterprise.”
